Road Safety Week: Monday 6th November – Friday 10th November 2023

Congratulations to Cayleigh Ward and Jack Ryan who have been appointed as Junior Road Safety Officers in Carrick Primary School. The children will be working alongside Mrs Kelly who is the Road Safety Coordinator and will be planning activities and events for Road Safety Week which takes place between Monday 6th November 2023 and Friday 10th November 2023. We are asking all the parents of the children who travel to and from school by bus, to emphasise to their children the importance of safely boarding the bus, going to a seat, remaining seated, wearing a seatbelt for the duration of the journey and behaving appropriately at all times. We appreciate your support in ensuring that these road safety messages are conveyed to our pupils, for their own safety and for the safety of others on the bus. Ditch the Dark Day will take place on Friday 10th November and the children are asked to wear bright coats/hats/scarves and reflective strips which are easily seen by drivers and other road users.

Music

Child Protection Assemblies

Mrs Kelly spoke to both P1-4 and P5-7 assemblies on Monday 25th September in relation to Child Protection and the school's Stay Safe Project. She also showed the children the Worry Boxes which are located in the three Key Stages and encouraged the children to use these if they have any concerns or worries about themselves or about another child.

ICT Online Safety Assemblies

On Monday 9th October 2023 Mrs O'Hare and Mrs Doran spoke to the P1-P4 and the P5-P7 assemblies respectively about staying safe online. They encouraged the children to always tell if they encountered anything inappropriate online.
